3	the title of the bill. The amendment removes from the bill a requirement that the cour			
4	finds that the individual has an abnormal condition of the mind as a result of ar			
5	intellectual disability or an autism spectrum disorder and instead requires the court to find			
6	that the individual has an intellectual disability or an autism spectrum disorder. The			
7	amendment provides that the sentencing discretion that the court has does not apply to a			
8	sentence for murder. The amendment adds an appropriations and allocations section.
