Services provided by independent speech-language pathology assistants for individual treatment must be reimbursed at 90% of the agency rate reimbursed as of January 1, 2017; and be it further

> This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, replaces the bill with The amendment sets the reimbursement rates for speech and language pathology services provided by an agency under Department of Health and Human Services rule Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 109 at 69% of the federal Medicare rate as long as the reimbursement rate is no lower than the current rate. It establishes that services provided by independent speech-language pathologists are set at 90% of the reimbursement rate for agencies. The amendment also establishes reimbursement rates for agency speech-language pathology assistants for group therapy at 69% of the federal Medicare rate for equivalent services for speech-language pathologists since there is no established Medicare rate for assistants. Rates for agency assistants

p.OT	1 2 3 4	providing individual therapy do not change from the rate reimbursed as of January 1 2017. Independent speech-language pathology assistant reimbursement rates are set a 90% of the agency rates for assistants. The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section.

The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$182,457 in fiscal year 2017-18 and \$182,509 in fiscal year 2018-19 for increased reimbursement of certain speech and language pathology services currently provided under Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 109, Speech and Hearing Services. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations will also be required for the FMAP match.
