1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6502-A, sub-§3-A is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6 7 8	3-A. Limits; Atlantic herring. The commissioner may adopt rules that establish different Atlantic herring landings limits for commercial pelagic and anadromous fishing license holders who recorded landings of Atlantic herring in this State prior to January 1, 2017 and who did not record landings of Atlantic herring in this State prior to January 1, 2017. Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.
