2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4013 is enacted to read:
3	<u>§4013. Lunch period</u>
4 5 6 7	<u>A school administrative unit shall provide for all students under the jurisdiction of the school administrative unit a lunch period of at least 30 minutes unless the governing body of the school administrative unit determines by vote after notice and public hearing that a 30-minute lunch period would be impracticable.</u>
