HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 544,
L.D. 764, Bill, "An Act To Prohibit the Exclusion of a Patient from Eligibility for an
Organ Transplant Based on Medical Marijuana Use"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act To Limit the Exclusion of a Patient from Eligibility for an Organ
Transplant Based on Medical Marijuana Use'**

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 10 in the first 3 lines (page 1, lines
15 to 17 in amendment) by striking out the following: "A transplant evaluator may not
determine a qualifying patient to be unsuitable to receive an anatomical gift solely
because the qualifying patient uses medical marijuana."

SUMMARY

This amendment removes from Committee Amendment "A" the provision that
prohibits a transplant evaluator from determining a qualifying patient to be unsuitable to
receive an anatomical gift solely because the qualifying patient uses medical marijuana.
