The amendment increases most reimbursement rates by January 1, 2019 for home health services under the Department of Health and Human Services rule Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 40 to 80% of the federal Medicare rates for these services. The rates for occupational therapy assistants, physical therapy assistants and speech and language assistants are increased by the same percentage increase as the respective specialists.
