14	The amendment increases most reimbursement rates by January 1, 2019 for home health						
15	services under the Department of Health and Human Services rule Chapter 101:						
16	MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 40 to 70% of the federal Medicare rates						
17	for these services. The rates for occupational therapy assistants, physical therapy						
18	assistants and speech and language assistants are increased by the same percentage						
19	increase as the respective specialists. The rates for clinical social work are increased by						
20	30% over current rates. The resolve requires an increase of 30% over current rates.
