1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §664, sub-§5 is enacted to read:
3	5. Exemption. Subsections 1 and 2 do not apply to an employee who:
4	A. Has not attained 18 years of age;
5	B. Is claimed as a dependent on the income tax return of another person; or
6 7	C. Is employed by a seasonal employer, as defined in section 603, subsection 3 paragraph F.
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill exempts from the minimum wage laws an employee who has not attained 18
10	years of age, is claimed as a dependent on the income tax return of another person or is
11	employed by a seasonal employer.
