3 4	D. The prohibition on the possession of a firearm does not apply to a person who possesses a firearm in a motor vehicle while dropping off or picking up a student.

6 7 8	This bill provides that the prohibition on the possession of a firearm on public school property or the property of an approved private school does not apply to a person who possesses a firearm in a motor vehicle while dropping off or picking up a student.
