Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §709, sub-§2, $\boldsymbol{q} \mathbf{L}$, as repealed and replaced by PL 2015, c. $494, \mathrm{Pt} . \mathrm{A}, \S 33$, is amended to read:
L. Licensees offering complimentary samples of wine under section 1055 ; or

Sec. 2. 28-A MRSA §709, sub-§2, $\mathbb{T}$, as enacted by PL 2015, c. 494, Pt. A, $\S 34$, is amended to read:
M. Product supplied by licensees Licensees authorized under section 1052-D supplying product for the purposes of providing taste-testing samples under a tastetesting event license-; or

## Sec. 3. 28-A MRSA §709, sub-§2, $\mathbb{\top} \mathbf{N}$ is enacted to read:

N. Offering a mail-in rebate under section 708, subsection 6 approved by the bureau that offers an incrementally greater discount based upon increased volume of purchased product.

## SUMMARY

This bill clarifies that a manufacturer or supplier of spirits or a certificate of approval holder may offer mail-in rebates approved by the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations that offer an incrementally greater discount for an increased volume of purchased spirits.
