15	§1111-B. Failure to inform law enforcement officer of hypodermic apparatus

A person is guilty of failure to inform a law enforcement officer of a hypodermic apparatus if the person in fact has a hypodermic apparatus in possession on the person's body and the person in fact fails to inform a law enforcement officer that the person is in possession of a hypodermic apparatus on the person's body during the course of any arrest or detention of the person.

A hypodermic apparatus or the contents of such apparatus is inadmissible as evidence in any prosecution for a violation of this chapter if the hypodermic apparatus was obtained as a result of the person's informing a law enforcement officer of the possession of the hypodermic apparatus as required by subsection 1.
25 26	3. Failure to inform a law enforcement officer of a hypodermic apparatus is a Class D crime.'
27	SUMMARY
28 29 30	This amendment replaces the bill and, like the bill, it establishes the failure to inform a law enforcement officer of a hypodermic apparatus as a Class D crime. If a person discloses the possession of a hypodermic apparatus as required, the amendment makes
