1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §10952, sub-§3 is enacted to read:
3 4 5	3. Exception. A person over 16 years of age may hunt for bear pursuant to subchapter 3 with a bow and arrow without an archery license under subchapter 2 if the person holds a valid bear hunting permit under section 11151, subsection 1.
6	SUMMARY
7 8	This bill exempts from the archery hunting license requirements a person over 16 years of age who hunts for bear under a valid bear hunting permit.
