This section does not prohibit an order, ordinance, rule or regulation of any political subdivision requiring that 14 15 a firearm carried inside an emergency medical services vehicle that is owned or operated 16 by or on behalf of the political subdivision be locked in a lockbox by emergency medical 17 services personnel.' 18 SUMMARY 19 This amendment is one of 2 minority reports from the committee. The amendment 20 does not prohibit a political subdivision of the State from adopting an order, ordinance, 21 rule or regulation requiring that a firearm carried inside an emergency medical services 22 vehicle that is owned or operated by or on behalf of the political subdivision be locked in 23 a lockbox by emergency medical services personnel.
