9 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{H} " to H.P. 781, L.D. 1107, Bill, "An Act To 10 Allow Municipalities To Adjust Times of Operation for Establishments That Serve 11 Alcohol"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 in paragraph A-1 in the first line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Notwithstanding paragraph A, onpremises" and inserting the following: 'On-premises'

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 in paragraph A-1 in subparagraph (1) in the first line (page 1, line 33 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "<u>extend by one hour</u>" and inserting the following: '<u>permit</u>'

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2 in paragraph A-1 in subparagraph (1) in the last line (page 1, line 35 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "<u>municipality</u>" the following: '<u>until 2 a.m.</u>'
