1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	<b>Sec. 1. 15 MRSA §3101, sub-§2, ¶C,</b> as amended by PL 1979, c. 681, §38, is further amended to read:

Juvenile Courts shall have jurisdiction over all petitions brought under the Uniform Interstate Compact on Juveniles, Title 34 <u>34-A</u> , chapter 9, <u>subchapter 7</u> pertaining to juveniles who have been adjudicated as having committed juvenile crimes in other states, but who are found within the territorial jurisdiction of <u>Maine the State</u> .
9	Sec. 2. 34-A MRSA c. 9, sub-c. 1, as amended, is repealed.
10	SUMMARY
11 12 13	This bill repeals the Uniform Interstate Compact on Juveniles. This compact has been superseded by the Interstate Compact for Juveniles, which has now been ratified by all states.
