1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 33 MRSA §752, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1997, c. 503, §1, is amended to
3	read:
4	1. Surcharge. In addition to any other fees required by law, a register of deeds may
5	collect a surcharge of \$3 per document for all records that are recorded in the registry of
6	deeds, except those recorded by agencies, including quasi-independent agencies, of State
7	Government and municipalities.
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill clarifies that quasi-independent agencies are not subject to the records
10	preservation surcharge imposed by various county registries of deeds.
