1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §12004-G, sub-§10-E, as enacted by PL 2013, c. 593, §1, is 3 repealed. 4 Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA c. 437, as amended, is repealed. 5 Sec. 3. 26 MRSA §1407 is enacted to read: 6 §1407. Maine Educational and Attainment Research Navigation System 7 1. Establishment. The Maine Educational and Attainment Research Navigation System, referred to in this section as "the system," is established within the department 8 9 for the maintenance and dissemination of information and data by the department and partner organizations and must include, but is not limited to, information and data on 10 education and training results, program completion, graduation, credentials earned and 11 12 employment and earnings outcomes for those who complete postsecondary education and other training programs in the State over time. 13 14 2. Executive council. The Maine Educational and Attainment Research Navigation System Executive Council, referred to in this section as "the council," is established. 15 Membership of the council must include, but is not limited to, the commissioner or the 16 commissioner's designee, the Commissioner of Education or the commissioner's 17 designee, the Chancellor of the University of Maine System or the chancellor's designee, 18 19 the President of the Maine Community College System or the president's designee and 20 the directors of the Bureau of Employment Services, the Bureau of Unemployment Compensation and the Bureau of Rehabilitation Services. The council shall provide 21 22 executive oversight of the development and direction of the system, including the establishment and refinement of policies and procedures for governance of the system, 23 24 and shall set the priorities of the system, approve all proposed policies and rules and 25 review annual reports. 26 3. Report. The department shall report annually to the Governor and the joint 27 standing committees of the Legislature having jurisdiction over workforce and education 28 matters on the development, use and plans for the expansion of the system. 29 **SUMMARY** 30 This bill establishes in statute the Maine Educational and Attainment Research 31 Navigation System, a longitudinal data series of education and training outcomes, within 32 the Department of Labor and creates the Maine Educational and Attainment Research 33 Navigation System Executive Council to provide oversight. It repeals the provisions 34 establishing the State Education and Employment Outcomes Task Force, which currently 35 develops procedures for the data series.
