M, §1, is 14 further amended to read: 15 5. Establish fees. To establish fees for admission to the Maine State Museum and 16 miscellaneous services. All revenues derived from these fees must be credited as . 17 undedicated revenue to the General Fund through June 30, 2014. Beginning July 1, 2014, 18 all revenues derived from these fees must be credited as dedicated revenue to the Maine 19 State Museum - Operating Fund, Other Special Revenue Funds account to be used to 20 support the operations of the Maine State Museum. The commission shall ensure that all 21 fees for admission to the Maine State Museum are waived for any resident of this State 22 who has served on active duty in the United States Armed Forces or has served in the 23 National Guard of any state or the Reserves of the United States Armed Forces or in the 24 merchant marine of the United States; and' 25 SUMMARY 26 This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, replaces the bill. It 27 directs the Maine State Museum Commission to ensure that all fees for admission to the 28 Maine State Museum are waived for residents of this State who have served on active 29 duty in the United States Armed Forces or have served in the National Guard, Reserves of 30 the United States Armed Forces or merchant marine of the United States. 31 FISCAL NOTE REQUIRED 32 (See attached)

Providing veterans with free admission to the Maine State Museum for the lifetime of the veteran will result in less dedicated revenue being received by the Maine State Museum from admission fees than would have been received had this provision not been in place. The museum has estimated the revenue loss at \$2,500 annually.
