Ordered, the House concurring, that all printing and binding authorized by the Legislature shall be under the direction of the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House.
(4-14) On motion by Senator CUSHING of Penobscot, the following Joint Order: S.P. 5
Ordered, the House concurring, that the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House purchase such services, supplies and equipment as may be needed to carry on the business of the Senate and House, respectively.
(4-15) On motion by Senator MASON of Androscoggin, the following Joint Order: S.P. 6
Ordered, the House concurring, that a sufficient number of the Legislative Record for the 128 th Legislature be printed, one copy for each of the members of the Senate and the House of Representatives who so desires, the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House. The remainder to be deposited with the State Law Librarian for exchange and library use; and be it further
Ordered, that a suitable index be prepared for such Legislative Record, under the direction of the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House.
(4-16) On motion by Senator MASON of Androscoggin, the following Joint Order: S.P. 7
Ordered, the House concurring, that when the House and Senate adjourn, they do so until Wednesday, January 4, 2017, at 10:00 the morning.
