(4-1) On motion by Senator MASON of Androscoggin, the following Joint Order: (S.P. 19)

ORDERED, the House concurring, that the Joint Rules be amended by amending Joint Rule 215, subsection 1 as follows:

1. Calling of United States Constitutional Convention <u>a</u> Convention for Proposing <u>Amendments</u>. An item requesting the calling of a United States Constitutional Convention applying to Congress for the calling of a convention for proposing an amendment or amendments to the United States Constitution requires a 2/3 majority vote of the members present in each chamber;
