1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §664-A, sub-§1**, as amended by PL 2009, c. 598, §29, is
3 further amended to read:

4 **1. Vehicle sold by dealer.** A vehicle that is sold by a dealer must be accompanied
5 by a properly assigned and valid certificate of title or certificate of salvage or a copy of a
6 valid certificate of title at the time of its sale. A dealer may retain and process certificates
7 of title and certificates of salvage at the dealer's primary facility if in the case when the
8 dealer displays a vehicle at an annex facility the dealer maintains a copy of the certificate
9 of title or certificate of salvage at the annex facility.

10 **SUMMARY**

11 This bill allows a dealer selling a motor vehicle to use a copy of the valid certificate
12 of title instead of the original valid certificate of title.
