COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 406, L.D. 562, Bill, "An Act To Improve Shoreland Zoning Rules and Enforcement To Support Municipalities"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in the 7th line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "basic and advanced" and inserting the following: 'basie'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in the 8th line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out "basic" and inserting the following: 'basie'

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, amends the bill by removing the requirement that the Department of Economic and Community Development, Office of Community Development provide both basic and advanced training to code enforcement officers in the technical and legal aspects of code enforcement and instead removes from existing law the designation that the training program required by statute be basic.
