1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §507-A** is enacted to read:

3 **§507-A. Separate bills**

4 **1. Separate bills.** A municipality may issue separate bills for the portions of its tax
5 commitment attributable to:

6 A. Education funding; and

7 B. County taxes and all other municipal costs.

8 **2. Information required.** Each separate bill issued under subsection 1 must contain
9 the information required under section 507.

10 **SUMMARY**

11 This bill permits municipalities to issue separate bills for the portion of their tax
12 commitments attributable to education funding and the portion attributable to county
13 taxes and all other municipal costs.
