1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §1461-B, sub-§7** is enacted to read:

3 **7. Funding.** An alternative organizational structure must be funded at the same level
4 as a school management and leadership center under chapter 123.

5 **SUMMARY**

6 This bill requires alternative organizational structures, a type of school administrative
7 unit, to be funded at the same level as school management and leadership centers.
