Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment eliminates the General Fund appropriations in the bill of \$32,601 in fiscal year 2019-20 and \$41,974 in fiscal year 2020-21 to the Department of Labor for one half-time Labor and Safety Inspector position and related All Other costs.

As amended, the additional costs to the Department of Labor to implement the requirements of this bill can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
