COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 575, L.D. 770, Bill, "An Act To Provide for a Later Starting Time for High Schools"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4801, sub-§2-B is enacted to read:

2-B. Start time. A school administrative unit may authorize a secondary school in the unit to start a school day no earlier than 8:30 a.m.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment allows a school administrative unit to authorize its secondary schools' school days to start no earlier than 8:30 a.m.
