SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 237,
L.D. 793, Bill, "An Act To Improve Accountability of Opioid Manufacturers"

Amend the amendment in section 3 in §13724 by striking out all of subsection 2
(page 2, lines 31 and 32 in amendment) and inserting the following:

'2. Manufacturer of an opioid medication fee. The fee for a manufacturer of an
opioid medication is \$55,000. This subsection does not apply to a manufacturer of an
opioid medication if all of that manufacturer's opioid medications are approved by the
United States Food and Drug Administration for use only in veterinary medicine.'

SUMMARY

This amendment exempts from the opioid medication fee a manufacturer of opioid
medications exclusively for use in veterinary medicine.

Excluding manufacturers of an opioid product or products from the annual license fee for manufacturers of opioid medication under certain conditions may reduce the amount of revenue deposited into the Opioid Use Disorder Prevention and Treatment Fund from the annual license fee. The amount cannot be estimated at this time.
