#### 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §907 is enacted to read:

#### 3 §907. Public hearing on direct initiatives

4 A petition for direct initiative of legislation under the Constitution of Maine, Article IV, Part Third, Section 18 that is determined valid by the Secretary of State pursuant to 5 section 905, subsection 1 and is submitted to the Legislature in accordance with the 6 7 procedure established in the Constitution of Maine, Article IV, Part Third, Section 18, Subsection 1 must be afforded a public hearing conducted by the joint standing 8 committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over the subject matter of the petition or 9 by a special legislative committee established for that purpose by the Legislative Council. 10 The public hearing must be conducted in the same manner as other public hearings. 11

### SUMMARY

This bill requires a petition for the direct initiative of legislation, once it has been certified by the Secretary of State to be submitted to the Legislature for consideration by the Legislature to receive a public hearing before a joint standing committee of the Legislature or a special legislative committee established by the Legislative Council. The public hearing must be conducted in the same manner as other public hearings.
