HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 937, L.D. 1294, "Resolve, Directing the Maine Human Rights Commission To Implement a Pilot Program To Investigate and Report on Incidents of Harassment Due to Housing Status, Lack of Employment and Other Issues"

Amend the resolve in section 1 by striking out all of the 3rd paragraph (page 1, lines 13 to 15 in L.D.).

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the 4th paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2020" and inserting the following: '2021'

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the 4th paragraph in the 4th line (page 1, line 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2021" and inserting the following: '2022'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes the authority of the Maine Human Rights Commission to establish an advisory board to assist the commission in carrying out the pilot program. The amendment also extends by one year the due dates for the interim and final reports of the commission.
