HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1049, L.D. 1437, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine Concerning Alternative Signatures Made by Persons with Disabilities"

Amend the resolution in section 20 in the 14th and 15th lines (page 1, lines 18 and 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "except when the Legislature by proper enactment has authorized alternative signatures for persons with disabilities," and inserting the following: "or, as authorized by law, the alternative signatures of persons with physical disabilities that prevent them from signing their own names,"

SUMMARY

This amendment revises the language in the resolution that allows alternative signatures for persons with disabilities signing a petition for a people's veto and for a direct initiative to clarify that the alternative signatures are authorized for use by persons with physical disabilities that prevent them from signing their own names.
