**An Act To Automatically Change a Voter Registration Address
upon Change of Address for a Driver's License**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §197 is enacted to read:

§197. Periodic update based upon change of address

The Secretary of State shall review on a weekly basis changes of addresses under Title 29-A, section 1407 and, if a person who has changed an address under that section is registered to vote in the State, the Secretary of State shall update the central voter registration system accordingly.

SUMMARY

This bill requires the Secretary of State to review on a weekly basis changes of addresses of driver's licenses and, if a person who has changed an address is registered to vote in the State, to update the central voter registration system accordingly.
