COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1215, L.D. 1700, "Resolve, To Promote the Inclusion of African-American History and Culture in the Curricular Offerings of School Administrative Units"

Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, Regarding African-American Student Data Analyses'

Amend the resolve by striking out all of section 1.

Amend the resolve in section 3 in the first 2 lines (page 1, lines 20 and 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ", in collecting information and preparing materials and under section 1,"

Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the requirement that the Department of Education collect information and prepare and make available materials that promote the rationale for adding African-American history and culture to the curricular offerings of school administrative units. The amendment also removes the requirement that the department identify educators in the State who are implementing model approaches to teaching African-American history and culture.
