HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1216, L.D. 1701, Bill, "An Act To Clarify Various Provisions of the Maine Human Rights Act "

Amend the bill in section 1 in §4553 by striking out all of subsection 5-D (page 4, lines 8 to 20 in L.D.).

Amend the bill in section 1 in §4553 in subsection 10 in paragraph F in the last line (page 8, line 37 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and" and inserting the following: 'and'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §4553 in subsection 10 in paragraph G in the 3rd line (page 8, line 40 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "bona fide nonprofit"


Amend the bill in section 1 in §4553 in subsection 10 in paragraph G in the blocked paragraph in the last line (page 9, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and" and inserting the following: ' '

Amend the bill in section 1 in §4553 in subsection 10 by striking out all of paragraph H (page 9, line 10 in L.D.).

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 8.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment make several changes to the bill, including removing the description of behaviors that might constitute harassment in reference to unlawful discrimination, removing the phrase "bona fide nonprofit" and removing language that would have held individual employees liable for their discriminatory behavior in certain circumstances.
