1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§103** is enacted to read:

3 **103. Pet food assistance organization.** Sales to an incorporated nonprofit
4 organization that provides for free or for a greatly reduced charge food or other supplies
5 intended for pets to owners of those pets who are low-income people.

6 **Sec. 2. Effective date.** This Act takes effect October 1, 2019.

7 **SUMMARY**

8 This bill provides an exemption from the sales and use tax for purchases made by
9 nonprofit organizations that provide pet food and supplies for little or no charge to low-
10 income owners of pets.
