COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 648, L.D. 1896, Bill, "An Act To Authorize Separate Alternative Compliance Payment Rates for Maine's Renewable Portfolio Standard and To Amend the Laws Governing Thermal Renewable Energy Credits"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Amend the Laws Governing Thermal Renewable Energy Credits'

Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble (page 1, lines 1 to 8 in L.D.).

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2.

Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency clause.

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the committee. The amendment removes the provision of the bill regarding separate alternative compliance payment rates for different resource classes and thermal renewable energy credits. It also removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause, which were related to the provision removed from the bill.
