28 **SUMMARY**

29 This amendment removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause and changes  
30 the date on which the rules governing the medical use of marijuana become major  
31 substantive rules to October 1, 2021. Due to the delay, this amendment also replaces the  
32 appropriations and allocations section to reduce the fiscal year 2021-22 cost.

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

The amendment removes the emergency preamble which reduces the Other Special Revenue Funds allocations to the Department of Administrative and Financial Services by \$261,712 in fiscal year 2021-22. The new expected start date is October 1, 2021 for the 8 Field Investigator positions and 2 Field Investigator Supervisor positions to handle increased inspections for providers to obtain compliance within the program.
