COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 12, L.D. 3, "An Act to Adopt Eastern Daylight Time Year-round Contingent on Federal Approval"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §151 in subsection 1 in the 5th line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "eastern"

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, clarifies the applicability of federal law or regulation permitting the year-round observation of daylight time by striking the word "eastern" from the contingency provision in the bill describing federal law or regulation permitting the year-round observation of daylight saving time.
