COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 13, L.D. 4, "An Act to Adopt Eastern Standard Time Year-round"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §151 by inserting after subsection 3 the following:

'4. Effective date. Year-round eastern standard time under subsection 1 takes effect at 2 a.m. on the 2nd Sunday of March 2026.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, sets an effective date for the adoption of year-round eastern standard time.
