Notification of New Hampshire's observance of eastern standard 18 time year-round. The Secretary of State shall notify the Secretary of the Senate, the 19 Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Revisor of Statutes when New Hampshire 20 enacts and effectuates legislation establishing eastern standard time as the standard time 21 for that state as provided in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 1, section 151, subsection 4. 22 23 Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or 24 section number to read consecutively. 25 SUMMARY 26 This amendment provides that year-round eastern standard time for the State takes 27 effect when New Hampshire enacts and effectuates legislation establishing eastern standard 28 time as the standard time-year-round for that state. It requires the Secretary of State to 29 notify the Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the House of Representatives and the 30 Revisor of Statutes when New Hampshire enacts and effectuates such legislation.
