The policy must be posted on the school board's school administrative unit's publicly accessible website. A school board shall seek
7 8	guidance from the department prior to adopting and implementing the written policy. SUMMARY
9 10 11 12 13	This bill requires school boards to adopt and implement a written policy establishing minimum and maximum temperature standards for school buildings. It requires the policy to be posted on the school board's school administrative unit's publicly accessible website. It also requires the school board to seek guidance from the Department of Education prior to adopting and implementing the written policy.
