COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 30, L.D. 18, "An Act to Allow the Department of Corrections to Increase Health Care Fees and Use the Proceeds from Those Fees to Offset the Costs of Client Medical Care Support Workers"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in the 5th line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$25" and inserting the following: '\$15'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in the 6th line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$25" and inserting the following: '\$15'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in paragraph A in subparagraph (8) in the first line (page 1, line 39 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$15" and inserting the following: '\$15 \$30'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, decreases the maximum medical and dental fees the department can charge from \$25 to \$15 and increases from \$15 to \$30 the maximum amount a client may have in the client's facility account to be eligible for free medical and dental services.

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes a revenue increase to the Department of Corrections, Other Special Revenue Funds of \$19,080 beginning in fiscal year 2025-26 from increasing the minimum amount a client has in their facility account from \$15 to \$30 to be eligible for free medical and dental services.
