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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 21, L.D. 57, "An Act to Enable Maine National Guard Commanders to More Efficiently Effect Disciplinary Measures Through the Maine Code of Military Justice"

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Amend the bill by striking out all of section 4.
Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

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SUMMARY

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This amendment retains a provision of current law that specifies that the state military forces consist of the Maine Army National Guard and the Maine Air National Guard when either or both are not in federal service.
