COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 23, L.D. 59, "An Act to Ban the Drug
Tianeptine"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the
emergency clause and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §1102, sub-§2, ¶M, as enacted by PL 2001, c. 419, §10, is
amended to read:

M. Ketamine and its salts, isomers and salts of isomers; ~~and~~

Sec. 2. 17-A MRSA §1102, sub-§2, ¶N, as enacted by PL 2001, c. 419, §10, is
amended by amending subparagraph (2) to read:

(2) One, 4-butanediol, BD, and its salts, isomers and salts of isomers; and

Sec. 3. 17-A MRSA §1102, sub-§2, ¶O is enacted to read:

O. Tianeptine.

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section
number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, replaces the bill and
changes tianeptine to a schedule X drug.

Establishes a new Class B crime. The current average cost of incarcerating one individual for a single year is \$55,200.

The additional workload associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system does not require additional funding at this time. The collection of additional fines will increase General Fund or other dedicated revenue by minor amounts.
