SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 58,  
L.D. 93, "An Act to Reduce Cost and Increase Access to Disease Prevention by Expanding  
the Universal Childhood Immunization Program to Include Adults"

Amend the amendment in section 10 in paragraph E in the 3rd line (page 1, line 34 in  
amendment) by inserting after the following: "1st." the following: 'The board shall develop  
the list to enable providers to make meaningful choices among available vaccine products.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or  
section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" by requiring that the Maine  
Vaccine Board, in developing the list of vaccines to be made available by the Universal  
Immunization Program, must develop the list to enable providers to make meaningful  
choices among available vaccine products.
