18	This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, clarifies that the Maine
19	Bureau of Veterans' Services within the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency
20 21	Management may release information regarding a deceased person's military service to the Department of the Attorney General, Office of Chief Medical Examiner for the purposes
22	of suicide reporting and prevention.

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
