1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §1512 is enacted to read:
3	<u>§1512. Missing persons list</u>
4 5 6 7 8	In cooperation with appropriate law enforcement agencies, the Bureau of State Police shall establish and maintain a publicly accessible website that lists all open missing person cases in the State. For each missing person listed, the website must contain a summary of the details of the case, a picture of the missing person and the contact information for the investigating agency.
9	SUMMARY
10 11	This bill requires the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of State Police to establish and maintain a publicly accessible statewide missing persons list.
