The department shall seek approval under this section as soon as practicable and, upon receipt of the approval, the department shall make the cost-of-living adjustment retroactive to the effective date approved by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.'

The amendment requires the Department of Health and Human Services to seek federal approval to implement a cr of-living adjustment (COLA) of 1.95% for reimbursement rates for essential support workers as required by Title. section 7402. Because General Fund appropriations and associated Federal Expenditure Funds allocations to implement a 1.95% COLA for reimbursement rates for essential support workers effective January 1, 2025 were included in Public Law 2023, chapter 17, no net fiscal impact is expected.
