adequate to cover the MaineCare allowable costs of operating a nursing home operated by the Maine Veterans' Homes to reflect any meaningful cost differences between veterans' and nonveterans' nursing home costs for the direct care and routine care cost components of the daily rate. Adjustments to rates and reimbursement for purposes that include, but are not limited to, audit procedures, quality and case mix must be made in the same manner as those adjustments are made for all other nursing homes as established in department rule.

B. For residential care facilities, rate calculations under this section must include an add-on per diem rate that is reasonable and adequate to cover the demonstrated MaineCare allowable costs of operating veterans' facilities that are residential care facilities when provided in addition to the per diem rates already established under MaineCare rules for reimbursement of residential care facilities. The add-on amounts are subject to cost settlement so that total reimbursement does not exceed MaineCare allowable costs for each facility.

4. Annual adjustments for inflation. The per diem rates must be annually adjusted
 for inflation to the same extent that MaineCare reimbursement rates for other nursing
 homes and residential care facilities that are not operated by the Maine Veterans' Homes
 are adjusted.

19 Sec. BBBB-2. Supplemental payments previously appropriated. Upon 20 implementation of the rate calculations process established in the Maine Revised Statutes, 21 Title 22, section 1708-A, any supplemental funding allocated or appropriated for the Maine 22 Veterans' Homes in Public Law 2023, chapter 412 that has not been expended may not be 23 used as supplemental payments but may be used for the purposes of this Part.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The amendment includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$5,455,878 in fiscal year 2025-26 and \$5,767,375 in fiscal year 2026-27 for per diem payments to Maine Veterans' Homes facilities for services provided to MaineCare members. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are included for the FMAP match and Other Special Revenue Funds allocations are included for the Nursing Facility Tax. A balanced budget is not maintained.
