Resolved: That the Department of Education shall communicate the importance of the adoption of seizure action plans to school administrative units, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 1, subsection 26, and approved private schools as defined in Title 20-A, section 1, subsection 2. The department shall provide information and assistance, if requested, to a school administrative unit or approved private school if the school administrative unit or approved private school requests information or assistance from the department on the adoption of seizure action plans.
26 27 28	For the purposes of this resolve, "seizure action plan" means a written, individualized health plan designed to acknowledge and prepare for the health care needs of a student diagnosed with a seizure disorder.'
29 30	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
