SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 181,
L.D. 277, "An Act to Repeal the Law Prohibiting Places of Business from Being Open to
the Public on Sunday"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in paragraph HH in the last line (page 1, line 27 in
amendment) by inserting after the following: "Day" the following: 'only between the hours
of 7 a.m. and noon and only if that grocery store pays an employee twice that employee's
ordinary wage for hours worked on Thanksgiving Day'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment incorporates the changes made by House Amendment "A" to
Committee Amendment "A" and requires a grocery store to pay an employee twice that
employee's ordinary wage for hours worked on Thanksgiving Day.
